- With the current recommendation to limit mass gatherings to very small numbers, we will conduct only graveside/memorial services in open, outdoor areas.
- Private viewings for immediate family members will be arranged on individual basis. Formal public visitations have been suspended until further notice.
- Funeral arrangements will be made by appointment, with a limited numbers of family members. Exposure to sick persons may require arrangements to be made remotely. Please call us to discuss these needs.

We sincerely appreciate your understanding as we work diligently to serve the community. As guidelines from the Center for Disease Control are altered, we will revisit our plan in order to stay in compliance. We pray for the safety and well-being of all!
